METHODOLOGY

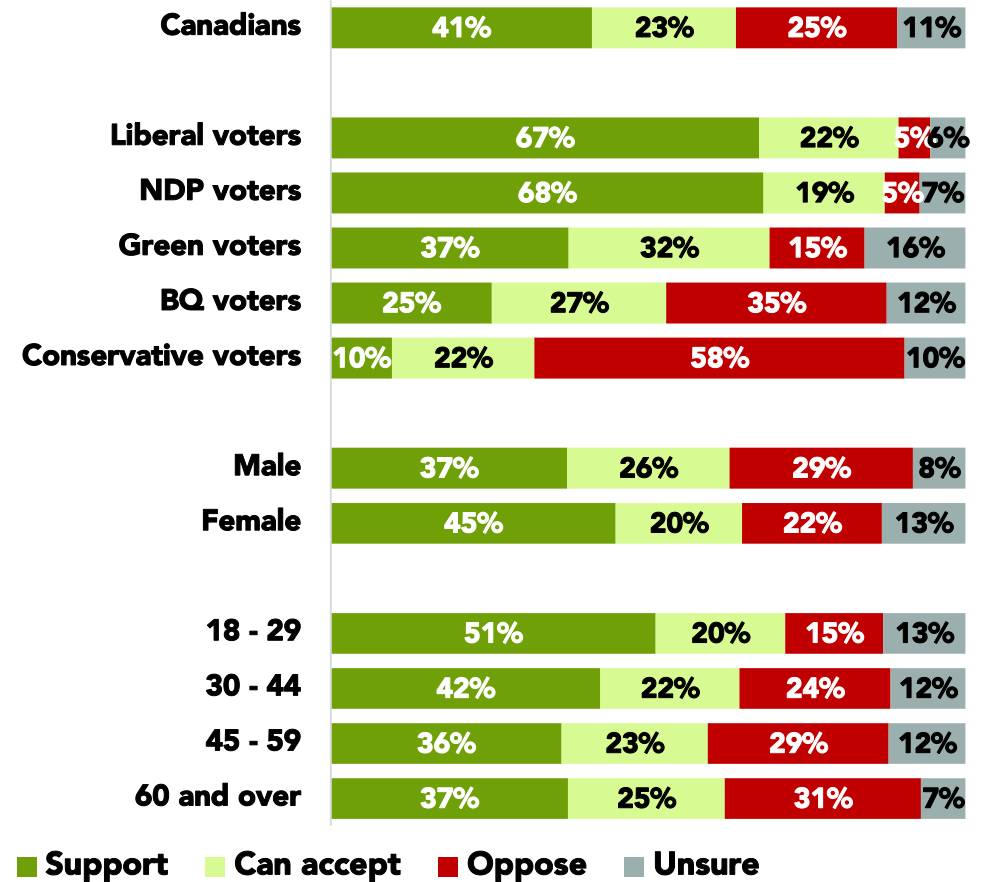
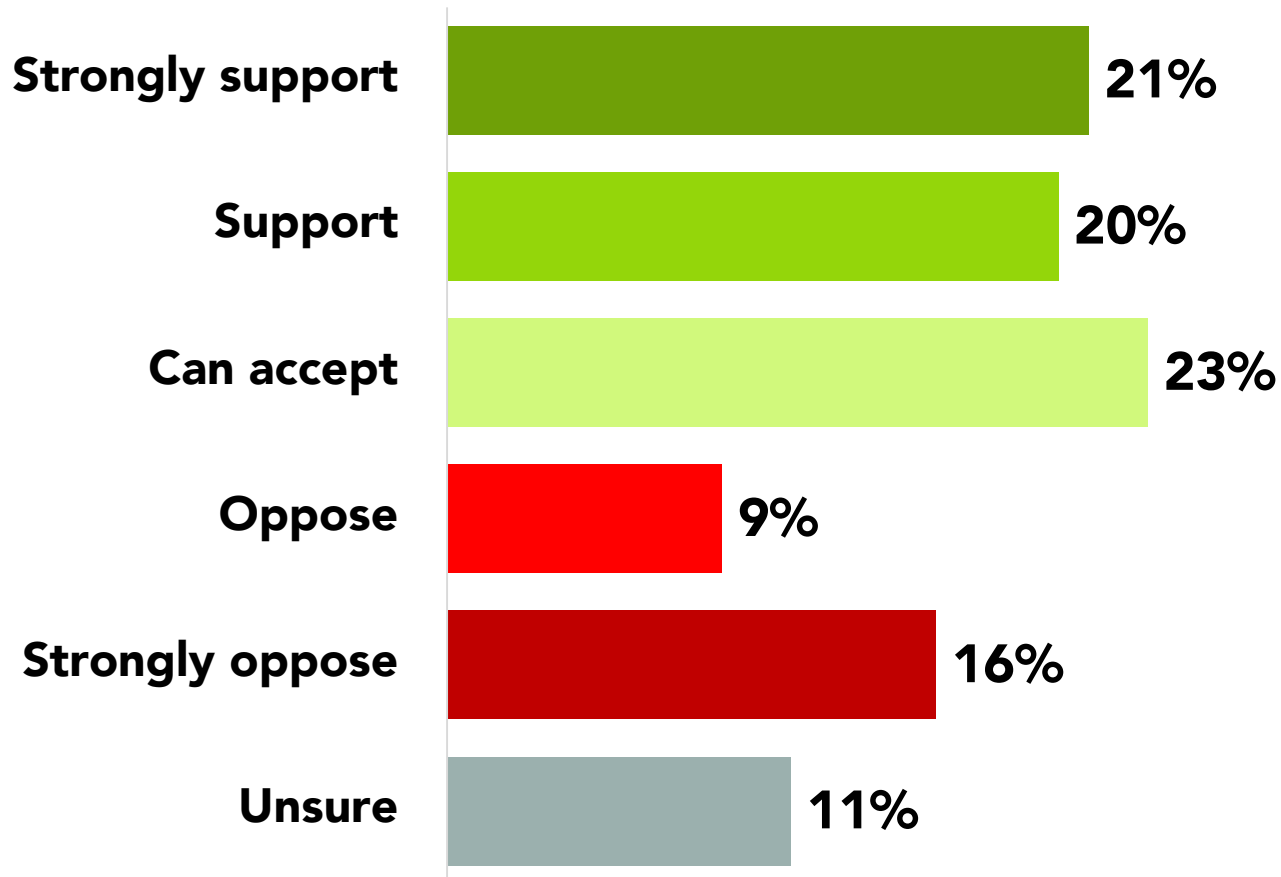
The survey, commissioned by the Broadbent Institute, was conducted online with 1,517 Canadian residents aged 18 and over, from October 22 to 24, 2019.

A random sample of panelists were invited to complete the survey from a set of partner panels based on the Lucid exchange platform. These partners are typically double opt-in survey panels, blended to manage out potential skews in the data from a single source.

The margin of error for a comparable probability-based random sample of the same size is +/- 2.2%, 19 times out of 20.

The data were weighted according to census data to ensure that the sample matched Canada's population according to age, gender, educational attainment, and region. Totals may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

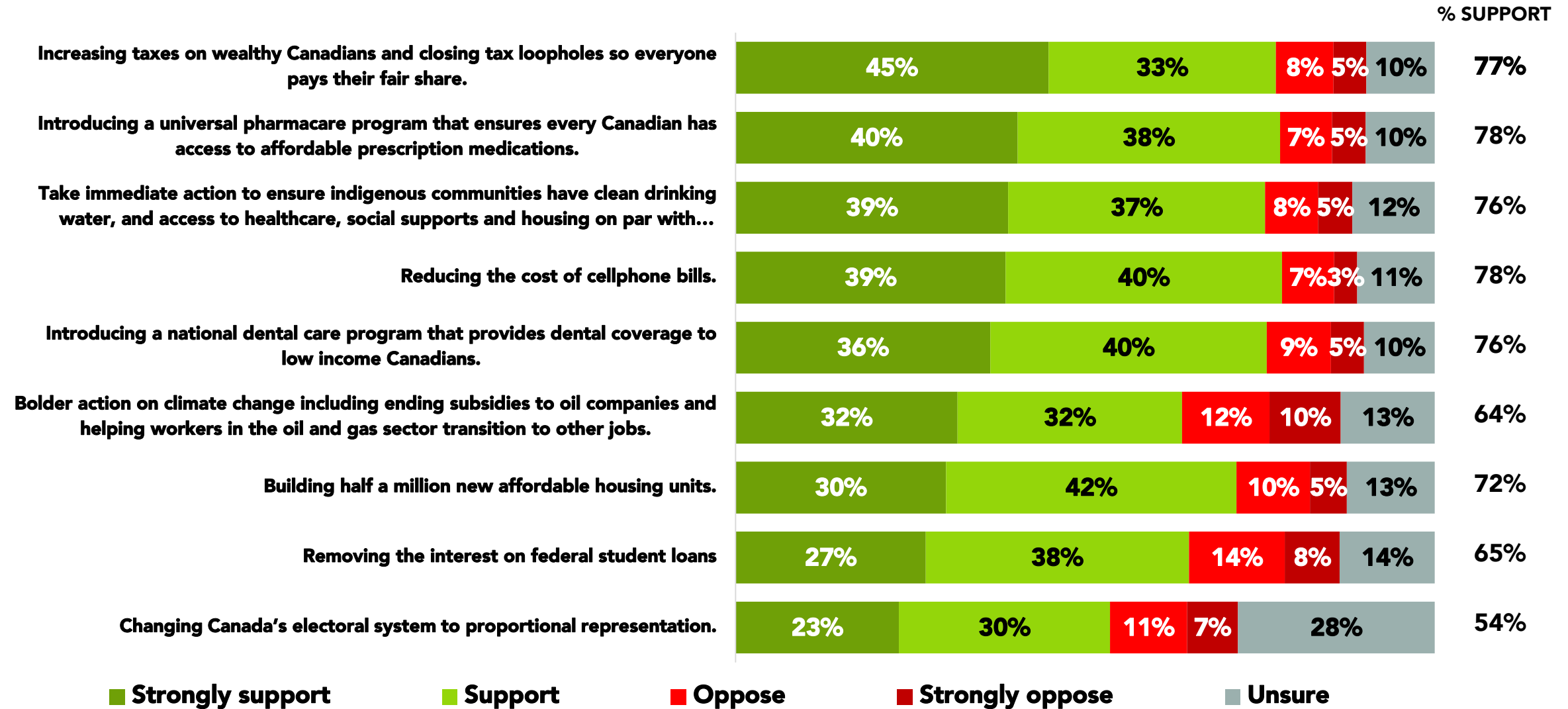

Do you support or oppose the Liberals and NDP working together in this way?

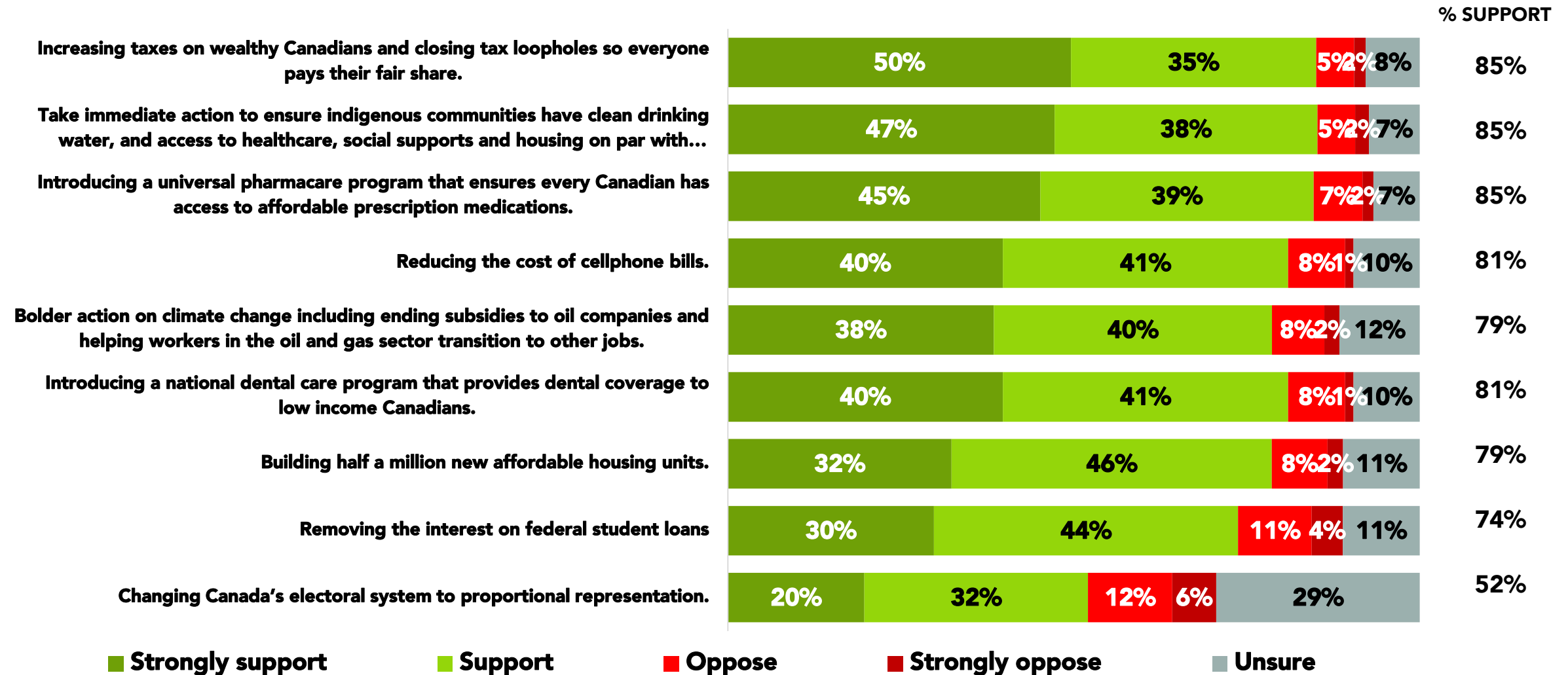

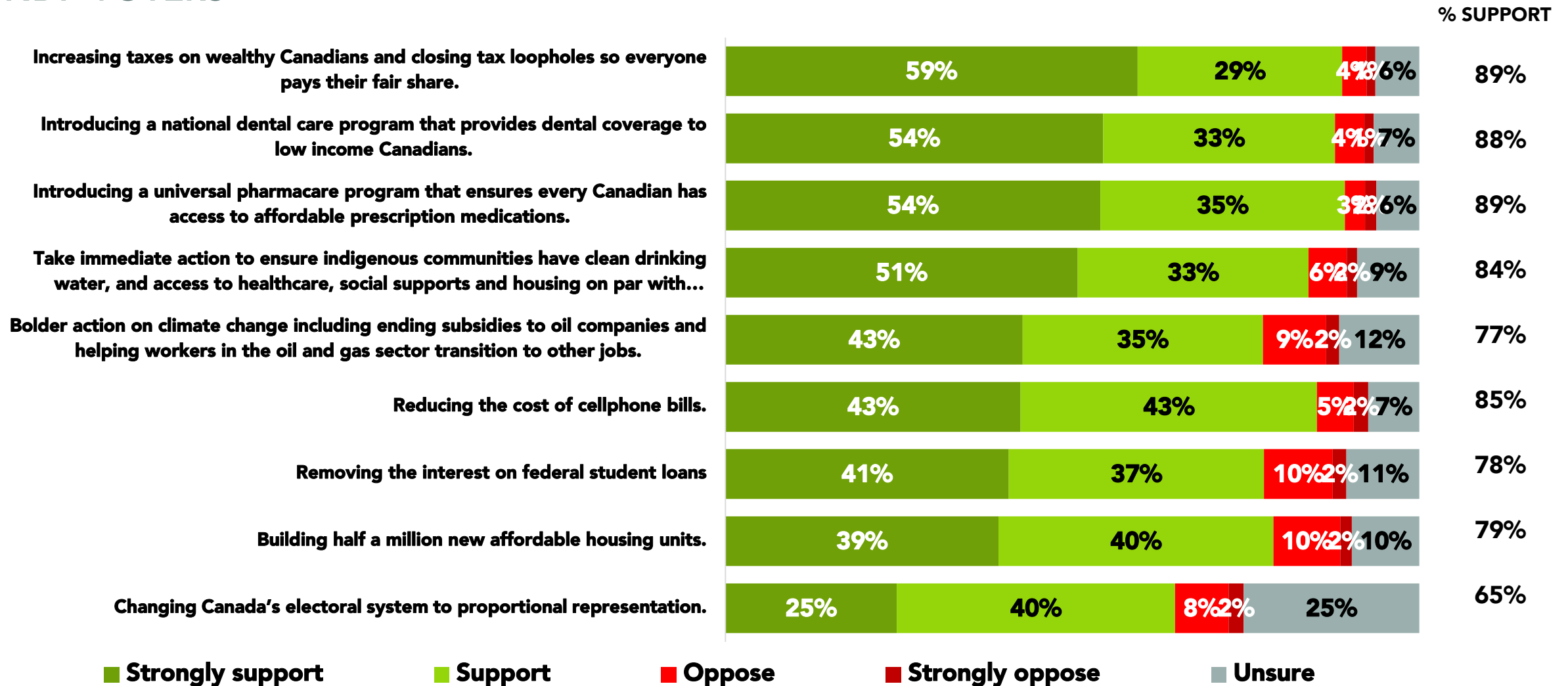

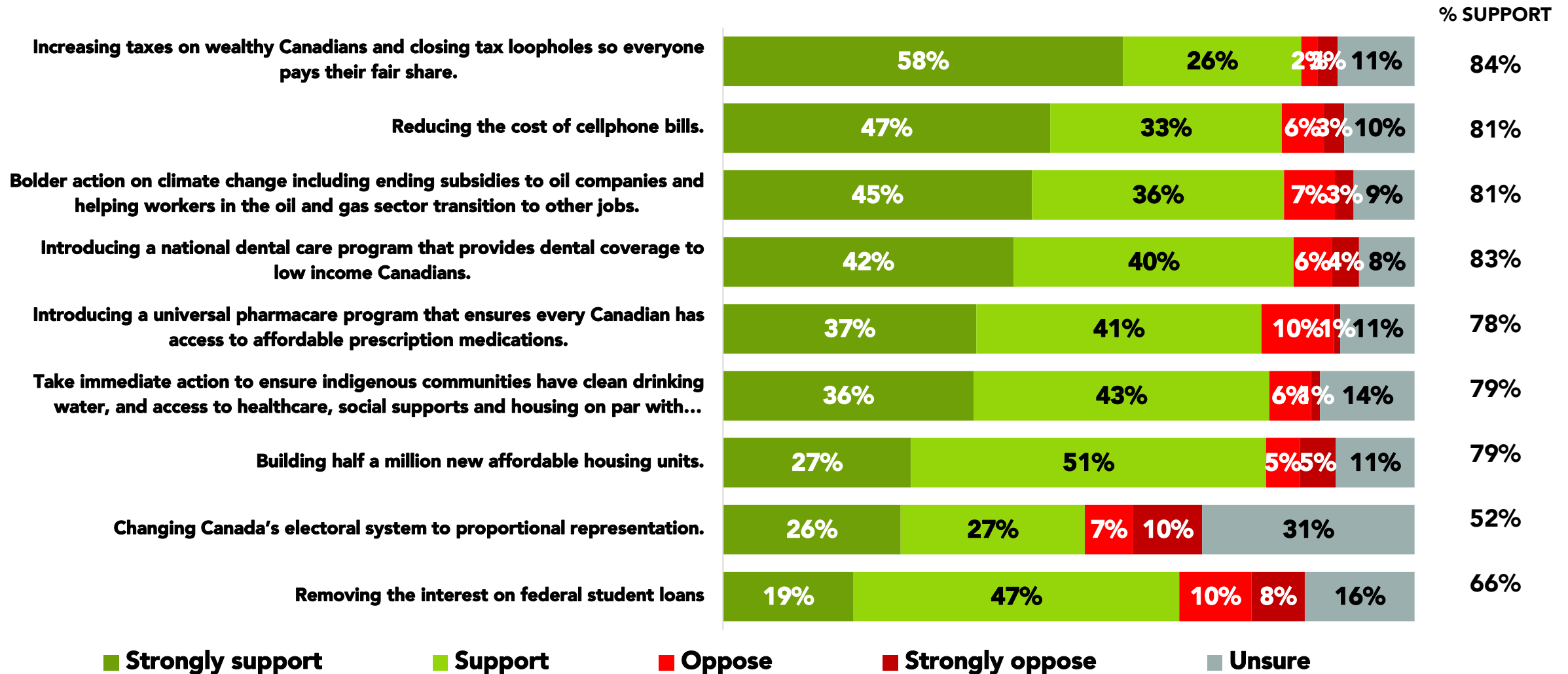

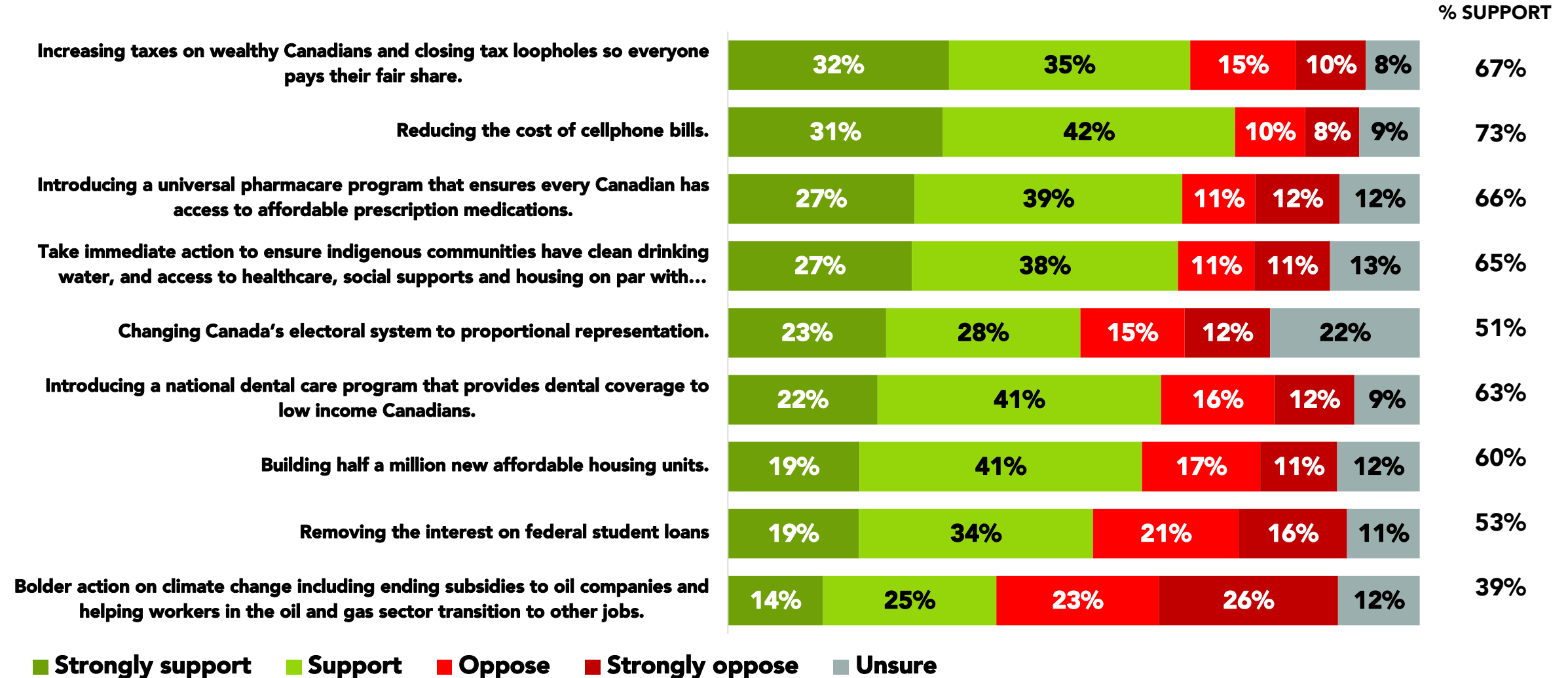

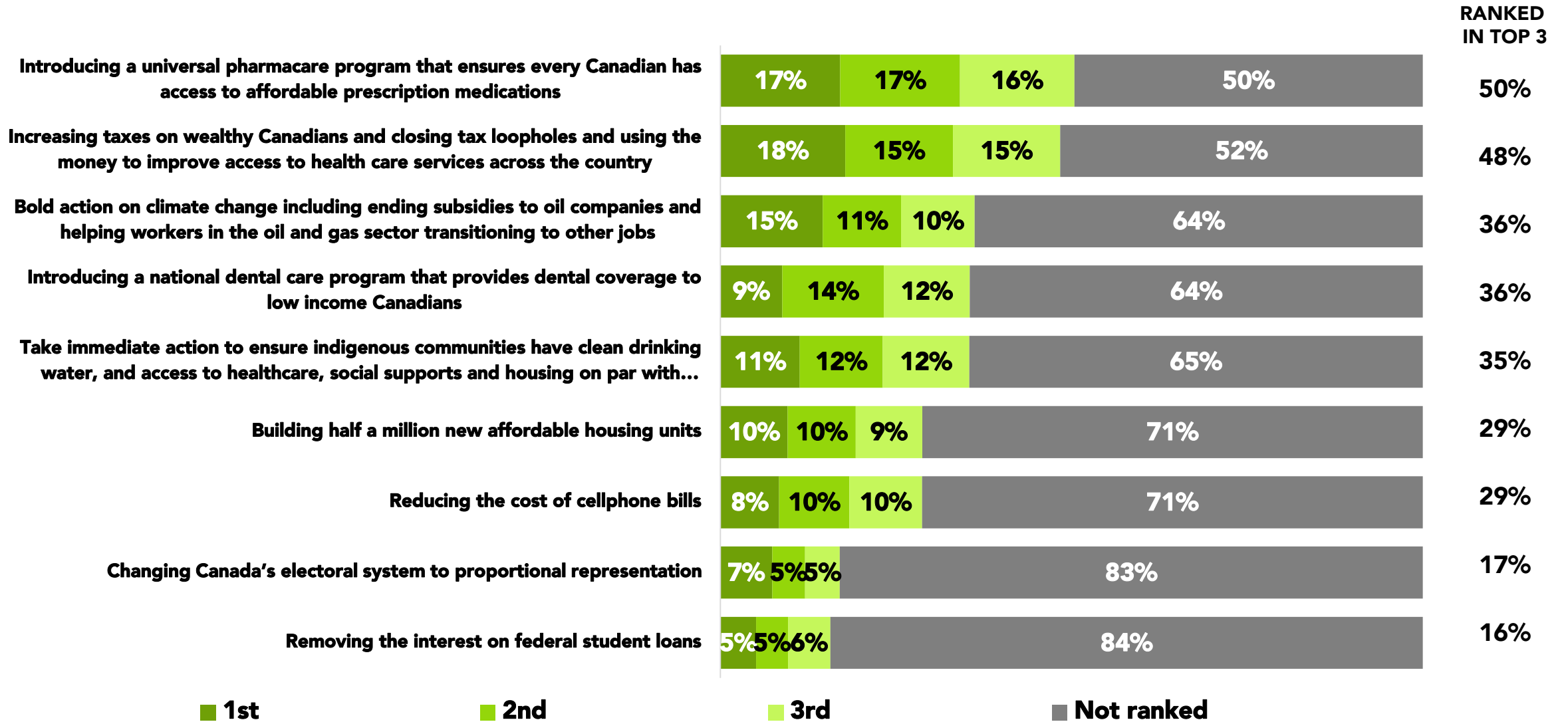

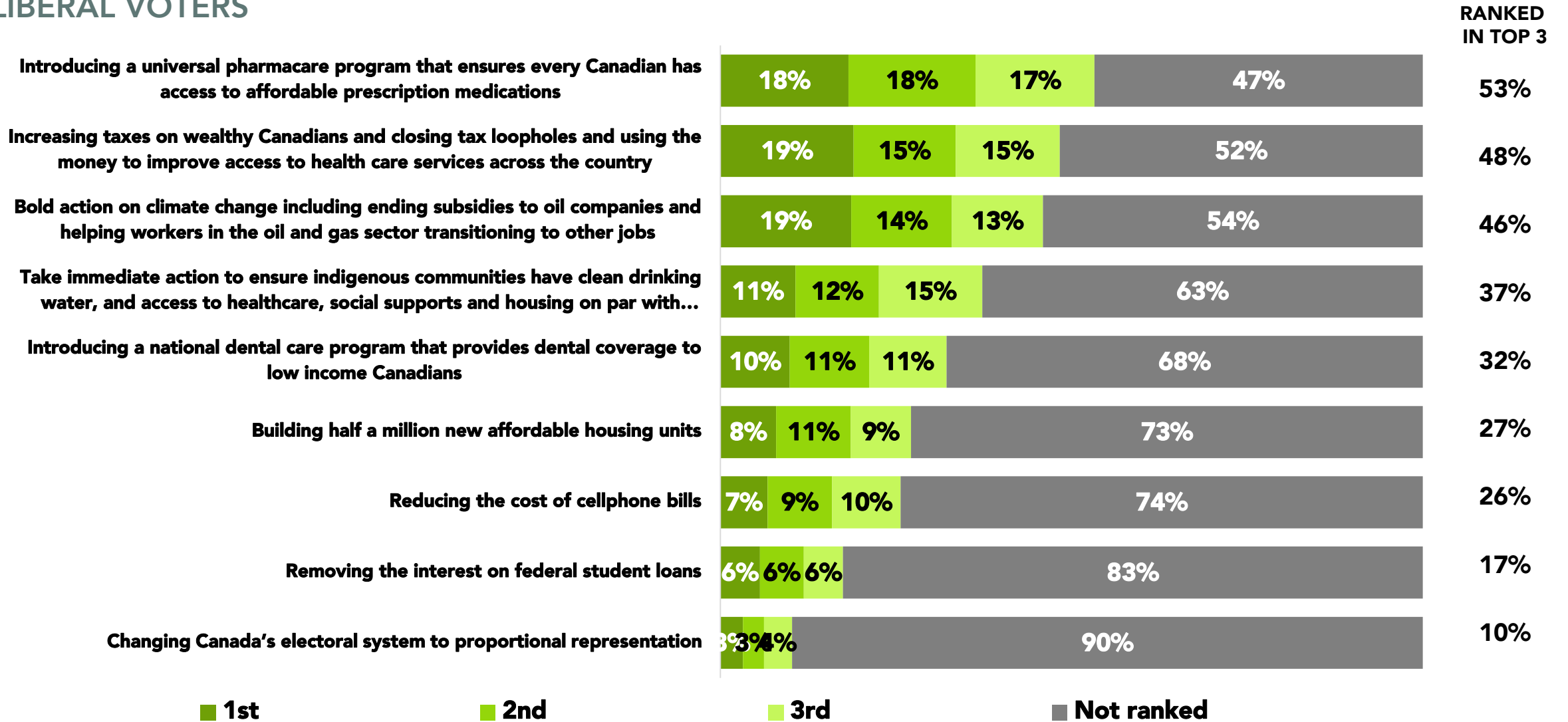

Which three ideas below would you MOST want to see the Liberals and NDP cooperate and focus their efforts on?

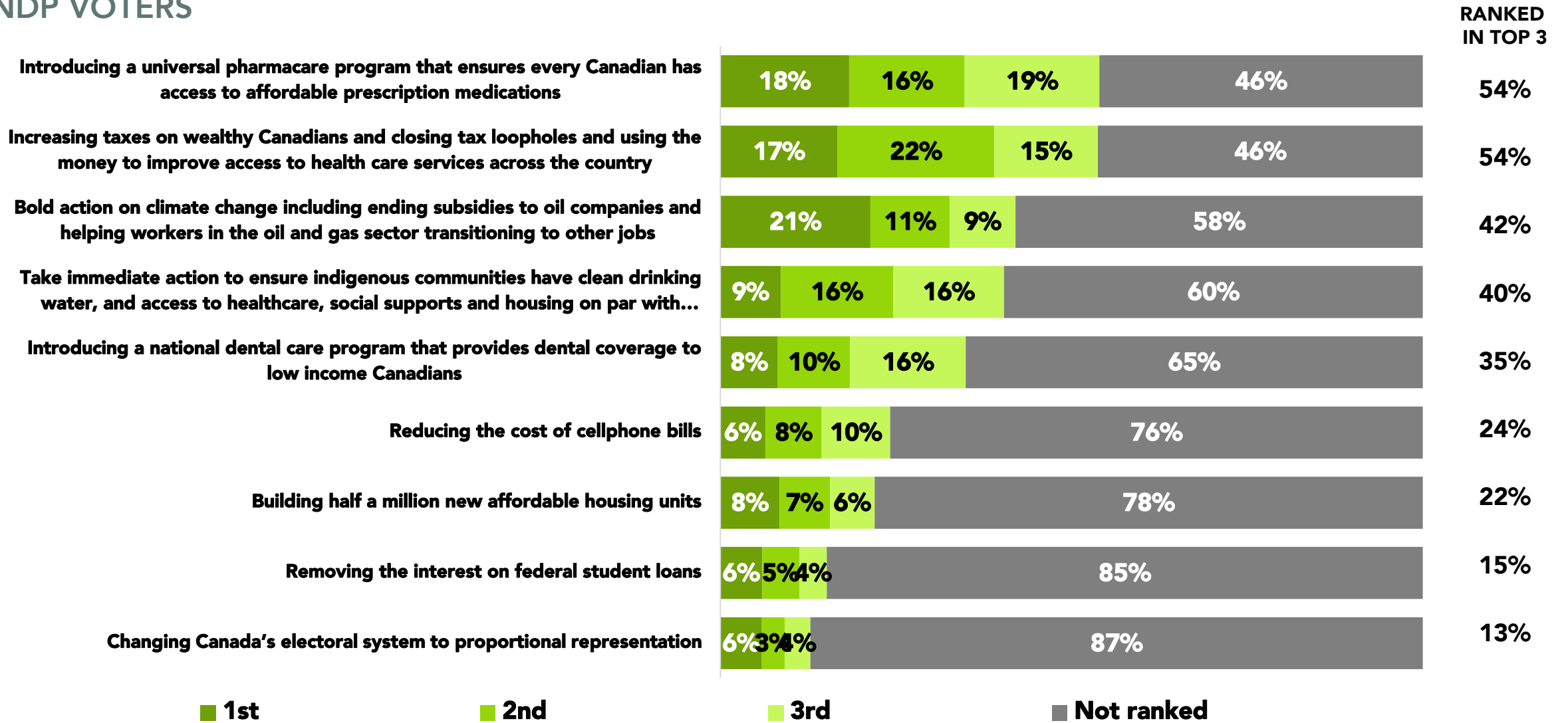
